

Giant Kelpfish



Description: Giant Kelpfish have slender, blade-shaped bodies that resemble blades of kelp. They can blend in with numerous types of kelp because kelpfish, just like seaweeds, can be a variety of colors; such as red, green or brown. They also have a silvery pattern running down their bodies. Kelpfish have long snouts.

Defense: The Giant Kelpfish is excellent at camouflaging. It even turns its body the same direction as the kelp that it hides in.

Where it is Found: The Giant Kelpfish can be found from British Columbia to Baja, California.

Diet: Kelpfish love to eat small crustaceans like crabs, mollusks and other small fishes.
