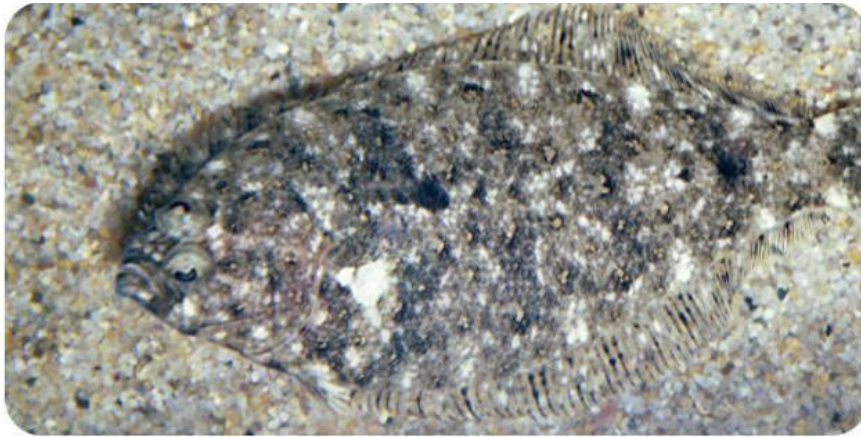


Sanddab

Description: The sanddab is a flatfish that spends most of its life on its side. They often bury themselves in the sand so that only their eyes are showing. They are most often found on the sandy seashore and can grow from 6 to 16 inches long. Sanddabs are related to halibut, flounders and sole.

Defense: the sanddab is excellent at camouflaging with its surroundings.

Where they are Found: Sanddabs are found from Alaska to Baja California.

Diet: Sanddabs like to eat worms, shrimp, squid and other fishes.
